Our AGM saw me reinstated as President with Michael Rowe assisting as Vice-President. Thank you for your support and best wishes.

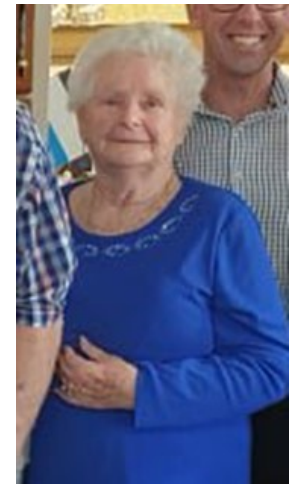
